4. You will need to keep a record of your community service hours. All hours must be signed by your supervisor or have him/her provide (2) letter stating the dates and total hours of community service on letterhead. One is for your AVID Teacher and the other is for Guidance.
5. Once you have submitted your community service hours to your AVID Teacher, you must also submit them to Guidance so your hours are recorded on your transcript.

***If you have already completed your hours, then you must show your AVID Teacher proof on your transcript. ***
