- TITLE:** Adapted Physical Education Teacher
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Certification in Adapted Physical Education and/or one or more areas of Exceptional Student Education.
- REPORTS TO:** Director of Exceptional Student Education
- POSITION GOAL:** To provide adapted Physical Education to selected schools.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To provide direct instruction for eligible students in order to increase their motor development and physical abilities.
2. To prepare individual educational goals, lesson plans, grades, and information to classroom teachers concerning student progress.
3. To ensure equitable use of adapted physical budget, materials, and facilities for the adaptive P.E. programs.
4. To assist in the development and implementation of curriculum and in-service activities for P.E. teachers and other county/school staff.
5. To serve as a resource to school personnel in the provision of P.E. to disabled students in the mainstream and the severely emotionally handicapped students.
6. To offer assistance to the community coordinator for Special Olympics as it relates to school involvement in the local, regional and state Special Olympic activities.
7. To assist in the provision of training programs for each of the Special Olympics events offered and to provide training in new Special Olympic events.
8. To perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Exceptional Student Education.

TERM OF EMPLOYMENT: Ten (10) months – Teacher Salary Schedule

EVALUATION: Performance in this position will be evaluated by the Director of Exceptional Student Education.
