Mr. Welch called the meeting to order.

#### Introductions

#### Minutes

The minutes from the February 24, 2021, meeting were approved with all ayes.

#### • Superintendent Update

Dr. Pace welcomed the Board and stated that the School District is currently in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. Dr. Pace stated the District is currently 73.5% face-to-face student enrollment and the District is preparing to conduct State Assessments beginning April 6, 2021 and continuing until the end of school in May 2021. She mentioned that there is steady growth in attendance for before school, after school, and Saturday school programs. Dr. Pace informed the Board that the District received information regarding the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> installments of Federal ESSER funding which will aid in academic learning programs and reimburse the District for Covid related expenses.

Dr. Pace stated that the District is looking forward as to what next school year is going to look like. She mentioned that it has been very hard on teachers and staff with the current digital platform and she would likely suggest to the School Board that the District offer only face-to-face learning or traditional virtual school.

She stated the District continues to monitor COVID vaccine guidelines and indicated the District will continue to work with the Department of Health to get additional employees vaccinated.

#### BUSINESS ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES MARCH 24, 2021

There was a brief discussion regarding adjusting this year's Sales Tax Revenue Forecast. The Board agreed to hold at the current forecast and continue to monitor collections next month.

#### Budget Update

Ms. Sarah Graber presented a Capital Funding History outlining funding trends from 2001 to 2020. There was discussion regarding the fluctuating trends in ad valorem, sales tax, and impact fee funding levels. Superintendent Pace suggested presenting the Capital Funding History graphs at the next Facilities Workshop on April 6, 2021.

Mr. Wells brought up Osceola County's penny sales tax and expressed concerns regarding the County's plans on marketing and moving forward with the next campaign. The Board suggested a meeting with all municipalities in order to have a successful marketing plan presented to the voters. Dr. Pace agreed to provide more information on the topic at the next BAB meeting.

Mr. Welch thanked Mr. Clinch for presenting the District's Projects in Design at a St. Cloud Chamber Meeting on Thursday, March 25, 2021. Mr. Welch enquired about the awards Facilities recently received.

#### • Facilities Update & Planning Department

Mr. Welch thanked Mr. Clinch for agreeing to present the District's Projects in Design at a St. Cloud Chamber meeting on Tuesday March 30, 2021. Mr. Welch enquired about the awards Facilities recently received.

Mr. Clinch thanked the Board for their support. He mentioned that the Facilities Department received several awards from FEFPA (Florida Educational Facilities Planners Association), including an award of merit for The Osceola Business Academy and 1<sup>st</sup> Place for Michigan Avenue Elementary School and St. Cloud Middle School for the shared facility concept, initial cost savings, and annual operational savings. Mr. Clinch stated that surrounding districts are taking notice and many are interested in the many advancements within the Osceola County School District.

Mr. Clinch presented a Planning Update and reviewed various Projects in Design and Construction. Mr. Lockard provided an aerial picture on the progress of the construction at Canoe Creek K-8.
