Facilities Update

Mr. Clinch presented and reviewed various Facilities and Maintenance projects. Mr. Clinch went over the soft opening scheduled for Michigan Avenue Elementary during Spring Break. The Business Advisory Board members commended the district and the Superintendent on doing a great job with the opening of Michigan Avenue Elementary. Mr. Clinch provided an update on the progress of NeoCity Academy and there was a discussion on Celebration Island Area Elementary School (ES-A).

BAB committee made a recommendation to Superintendent Pace to enhance our marketing of the sales tax program to let the community know where their 1/2 penny sales tax dollars are being spent.

Dr. Pace updated the board on her upcoming meeting with the district's OLE committee and the upcoming trip to Tallahassee to represent Osceola County's interest. 
