#### MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BELLALAGO EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES BENEFIT DISTRICT WEDNESDAY, MARCH 27, 2019 AT 2:00 P.M. BELLALAGO CHARTER ACADEMY

**PRESENT:** Migdalia Gonzalez, School District of Osceola County, Jasper Thompson, Osceola County, Lisa Lynch, School District of Osceola County, Nicholas Gluckman, Taylor Morrison.

Also present were Angela G. Barner, Benefit District Manager and Jonathan Rasmussen, Principal for Bellalago Charter Academy. Christopher Roe, Bryant Miller Olive joined the meeting via telephone.

#### Introduction

Migdalia Gonzalez called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

#### **Board Matters**

#### 1. Approval of the August 8, 2018 Board Meeting Minutes

A motion to approve the minutes for the August 8, 2018 Board Meeting was made by Jasper Thompson and seconded by Lisa Lynch. The motion passed 4-0.

#### 2. Jason Good Resignation

The Board of Supervisors acknowledged and accepted Jason Good's resignation from the Bellalago EFBD Board of Supervisors, submitted on December 19, 2018.

#### 3. Resolution 2019-1 Appointing Nicholas Gluckman to Seat 1

A motion to approve Resolution 2019-1 Appointing Nicholas Gluckman to Seat 1 was made by Jasper Thompson and seconded by Lisa Lynch. The motion passed 4-0.

#### 4. BEFBD Background Information and Expansion Updated

Attorney Chris Roe provided background information regarding the formation, purpose and functions of the BEFBD. Attorney Roe explained that the board was recently expanded to include one additional appointed seat from the School District of Osceola County and one additional appointed seat from Osceola County Government. The expansion will allow the board to have a quorum to meet in the event that there is no landowners interest or participation.

#### 5. Audited Financial Statements for Fiscal Year Ended 9/30/2018

A motion to accept the Audited Financial Statements for Fiscal Year Ended 9/30/2018 was made by Jasper Thompson and seconded by Nicholas Gluckman. The motion passed 4-0.

#### 6. Remaining HVAC Project Funds

Angela Barner explained that the 2016-17 HVAC Chiller Replacement Project was funded from the BEFBD Capital Repair Reserve Account for \$650,988. The project actual cost was \$366,071.72. Angela Barner requested to use the unused \$284,916.28 to fund the Chiller Enclosure Project for \$196,483.73 and a portion of the HVAC Air Handler Replacement Project for \$88, 432.55.

(Note: The board packet listed a HVAC Controls Replacement Project incorrectly; the correct project is the HVAC Air Handler Replacement Project.)

A motion to approve funding the Chiller Enclosure Project for \$196,483.73 and a portion of the HVAC Air Handler Replacement Project for \$88,432.55 by utilizing the unused funds from the 2016-17 HVAC Chiller Replacement Project was made by Jasper Thompson and seconded by Lisa Lynch. The motion passed 4-0.

#### 7. Bellalago Charter Academy Fence

Dr. Rasmussen discussed the current condition of the fence and his concerns over the safety of the school and students. There were two options submitted by the School District of Osceola County Facilities Department for consideration. Option 1 – Omega Fence for \$832,274 and Option 2 – Black Vinyl Chain Link Fence for \$388,771.

Nicholas Gluckman explained that when Taylor Morrison acquired the assets owned by AV Homes within the BEFBD, it did not anticipate participating in the maintenance of the school. However, Mr. Gluckman would like to work with the School District on both the Fence Project and the Chiller Enclosure Project, as they may have access to lower contract prices. Also, in the event that the fencing does not yield the desired aesthetics, there may be a possibility that Taylor Morrison would fund planting shrubs along the fence to soften its look.

#### 8. May, 2019 – Supervisor Elections

Angela Barner reminded the board that there will be an Election Meeting on May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Bellalago Welcome Center.
