Celebration High School's AVID Community Service Guidelines

Seniors	20	80

Rules for Community Service:

- 1. Volunteer hours must be done at a Non-Profit Organization
- 2. You must provide proof of community service hours. You will be given an AVID Community Service Log as well as a Celebration High School Community Service Log.
- 3. The location you volunteer at must sign the service log or it must be on letterhead.
- 4. You will need to keep a record of your community service hours. All hours must be signed by your supervisor or have him/her provide (2) letter stating the dates and total hours of community service on letterhead. One is for your AVID Teacher and the other is for Guidance.
- 5. Once you have submitted your community service hours to your AVID Teacher, you must also submit them to Guidance so your hours ae recorded on your transcript
- ***If you have already completed your hours, then you must show your AVID Teacher proof on your transcript. ***
