Mr. Welch called the meeting to order.

Minutes

The minutes from the May 26, 2021, meeting were approved with all ayes.

Mr. Bass inquired about the current and recurring funding needs for the district's white fleet.

Mr. Filak asked about the district's role with the upcoming penny sales tax campaign for renewal of this funding in which the school district currently receives a ¼ penny. Ms. Graber mentioned that while the County owns the process, the school district would be heavily involved in an education campaign to explain to the community what the financial needs are and how this funding would be used.

Budget Update

Ms. Graber stated her team is currently preparing the annual budget for all funds which will be presented at the July 13th school board meeting as information only. The first of two required public hearings will then be held on August 3rd, and the final budget hearing and adoption of the millage rates is scheduled for September 7th.

Ms. Graber shared that the district has fully expended the first round of the Federal Cares Act dollars and has begun spending the second round, ESSER II. The third round, American Recovery Plan funds, have not yet been received or made available to local school districts; however, the district has a comprehensive plan for these grant funds to be spent over the next three years. The primary uses of these funds will be for additional summer and after hours remediation time to address student learning loss, implementing

a one-to-one digital device program including technology infrastructure and staffing, COVID related costs, and additional strategic initiatives of the school board.

• Facilities Update & Planning Department

Mr. Clinch thanked the BAB members for their continued support. Mr. Clinch and Mr. Lockard presented a Construction and Facilities Update, including aerial pictures on the progress of the construction at Canoe Creek K-8 and the oTECH Welding project.

There was a question about the split-funding of Canoe Creek K-8. Ms. Graber shared that sales tax was used to acquire the previous charter school and fund initial renovations, while impact fees are being used for the expansion portion of the project to increase the number of student stations at this school.

Ms. Graber congratulated Mr. Clinch and his team on receiving only minor findings and high acclamations from the audit firm on the recent internal audit over the Design and Construction functions. Mr. Clinch thanked Ms. Graber and the Board. He mentioned that the implementation of the E-Builder Program has successfully streamlined the Facilities processes on all construction projects.

Ms. Graber shared that the new Health Services Plan implemented last year is resulting in savings and the district foresees a surplus for this year, as expected.

Mr. Welch thanked Ms. Graber and her team for coming to present the Impact Fee Study to the St. Cloud Chamber on Tuesday, June 29, 2021.

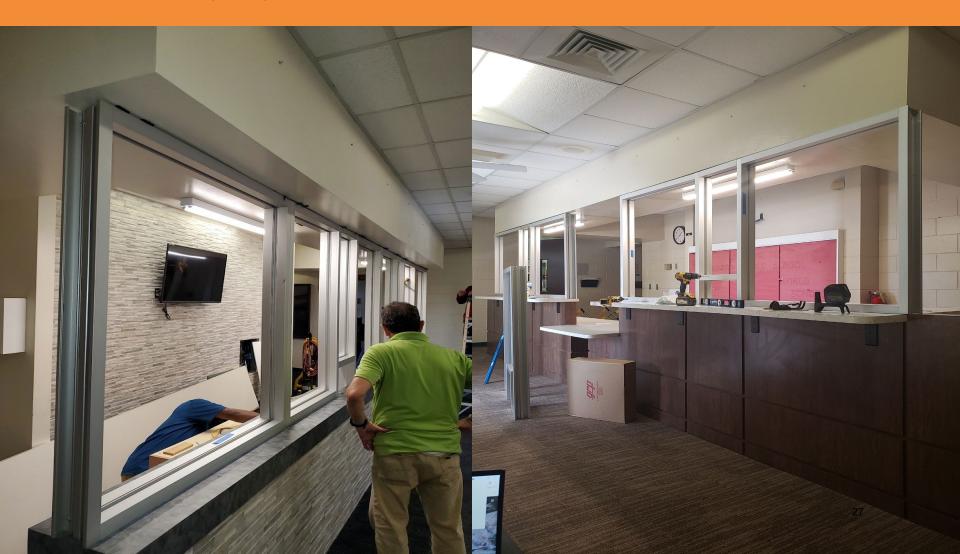






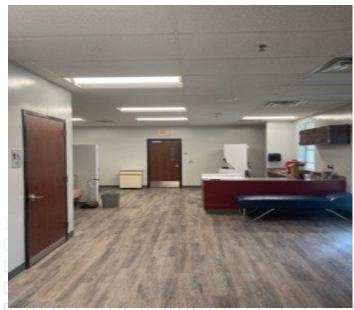
