(f) 80 percent of each district's Teacher Salary Increase Allocation, pursuant to section 1011.62, F.S., is for school districts and charter schools to provide a minimum base salary of \$47,500 or the maximum amount achievable for full-time classroom teachers as defined in s. 1012.01(2)(a), F.S., including prekindergarten teachers funded through the FEFP but not including substitute teachers. The remaining 20 percent of the allocation, plus any remaining funds from the district's share of the 80 percent allocation, shall be used by the school districts as specified in s. 1011.62, F.S., to provide salary increases to full-time classroom teachers who received an increase of less than 2 percent, or other instructional personnel.

This allocation was calculated in the 2020-21 FEFP Second Calculation and will not be recalculated throughout the year. Charter schools should contact their sponsoring school district to determine the school's allocation amount.

(f) The Best and Brightest Teacher and Principal Allocation is provided pursuant to s. 1011.62(18), F.S., to recruit, retain and recognize classroom teachers, instructional personnel and school principals. Award requirements are established in s. 1012.731, F.S., and s. 1012.732, F.S. Charter schools should contact (g) Numbers entered here will be multiplied by the district level transportation funding per rider.
