Student Commitments

- Help keep Poinciana High School safe by notifying trusted school staff of potential problems
- Follow district Code of Conduct rules and procedures at school, on the bus and at all special events

Parent/Guardian Commitments

- Establish a supportive home environment that encourages learning and accepting new challenges
- Make sure my child attends school on time each day, or report any anticipated absences to the office
- Use the Parent Portal to see that all assignments are completed and submitted on time
- Communicate regularly and respectfully with my child's teachers, counselors and school administration
- Confer with my child's counselor about course selection to make sure he/she is on track for graduation
- Become an OASIS Volunteer and get involved in events at Poinciana High School
- Attend monthly SAC meetings and share my input to improve the school
- Stay up-to-date on important school news by attending Parent Nights, visiting the PHS website, reading Remind messages, listening to automated phone calls and following PHS on official social media accounts

Teacher Commitments

- Create a classroom environment conducive to learning, and ensure material is fully understood
- Provide meaningful and appropriate assignments, and enter grades into Focus on a weekly basis
- Enforce school and classroom rules consistently and apply discipline fairly
- Maintain open lines of professional and respectful communication with students' families
- Respond to parental emails within 24 hours, or forward to appropriate staff members for a prompt response
- Seek ways to involve parents, volunteers and industry professionals in the school program
- Share my "Why?" with students and families

School Administration and Staff Commitments

- Believe that <u>all</u> PHS students have the potential to succeed, and ensure they receive a quality education
- Foster a "No Excuses" climate of personal accountability and growth for all students and staff
- Celebrate success and work toward continuous improvement throughout the school community
- Ensure that information is distributed in a timely manner, or readily available on the school website
- Solicit input, ideas, and proposed solutions by all stakeholders before making decisions
