POSITION DESCRIPTION

TITLE:	Career and Technical Education Resource Teacher
QUALIFICATIONS:	 Appropriate technical education or apprenticeship required beyond high school with Career and Technical Education certification Bachelor's Degree and/or industry certifications preferred A minimum of three years successful teaching experience in a Career and Technical Education subject area
REPORTS:	Director of Career and Technical Education
POSITION GOAL:	Assist in the assessment, planning, development, implementation, and evaluation of the overall management of the Career and Technical Education instructional programs

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Develop, manage, and implement curriculum for all student courses related to the appropriate content area as needed.
- 2. Facilitate the integration of core academic concepts into technical curricula.
- 3. Collaborate with the appropriate core subject resource teacher to facilitate integration of core concepts into technical curricula.
- 4. Implement state and national educational initiatives related to the appropriate content area.
- 5. Initiate and manage the instructional material adoption process related to the appropriate content area.
- 6. Advocate for the effective participation in Career and Technical Student Organizations (CTSO) by teachers and students.
- 7. Plan and implement professional development as required.
- 8. Ensure that Exceptional Student Education students have equal access to instruction and materials related to the appropriate content area.
- 9. Assist in making effective recommendations to principals and district staff in planning, developing, and administering Career and Technical Education programs.
- 10. Assist new teachers with effective curriculum presentation and classroom management.
- 11. Prepare reports and maintenance records as required for Career and Technical Education equipment and processes.
- 12. Assist teachers in preparing requests for equipment purchases.
- 13. Assist in preparation of budgets as requested.
- 14. Facilitate and conduct meetings with Career and Technical Education teachers as needed and appropriate.
- 15. Assist Career and Technical Education teachers by conducting regular school-site visits.
- 16. Facilitate, monitor, and assist teachers in developing and managing effective industry advisory committees for each Career and Technical Education program.
- 17. Assist in the purchase and facilitate the repair of Career and Technical Education equipment as budgeted.



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PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES (continued):

- 18. Assist in recommending program and curriculum changes and/or expansion.
- 19. Assist in implementing new Career and Technical Education programs including facilities, equipment, instructional materials, supplies, and staff needs.
- 20. Assist in the preparation of proposals for local, state, and federal funds.
- 21. Assist in establishing a comprehensive safety program for Career and Technical Education.
- 22. Establish and maintain effective communications with teachers, administration, industry, and the community.
- 23. Attend school, district, and community activities as needed.
- 24. Perform other duties as assigned.
