TITLE: Adapted Physical Education Teacher

QUALIFICATIONS: Certification in Adapted Physical Education and/or one or more areas of Exceptional Student

Education.

REPORTS TO: Director of Exceptional Student Education

POSITION GOAL: To provide adapted Physical Education to selected schools.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. To provide direct instruction for eligible students in order to increase their motor development and physical abilities.
- 2. To prepare individual educational goals, lesson plans, grades, and information to classroom teachers concerning student progress.
- 3. To ensure equitable use of adapted physical budget, materials, and facilities for the adaptive P.E. programs.
- 4. To assist in the development and implementation of curriculum and in-service activities for P.E. teachers and other county/school staff.
- 5. To serve as a resource to school personnel in the provision of P.E. to disabled students in the mainstream and the severely emotionally handicapped students.
- 6. To offer assistance to the community coordinator for Special Olympics as it relates to school involvement in the local, regional and state Special Olympic activities.
- 7. To assist in the provision of training programs for each of the Special Olympics events offered and to provide training in new Special Olympic events.
- 8. To perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Exceptional Student Education.

TERM OF EMPLOYMENT: Ten (10) months – Teacher Salary Schedule

EVALUATION: Performance in this position will be evaluated by the Director of
