POSITION GOAL: To provide direct behavioral service to students and teachers through the use of

behavioral analysis and compliance training.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To act as a direct service professional to ESE students who need behavioral training.

2. To assist teachers in developing behavioral plans for ESE students who exhibit extreme disruptive or non-compliant behavior.

- 3. To provide inservice for teachers and other professionals who work with students with behavioral difficulties.
- 4. To assist in the implementation of a district wide behavior management systems for ESE students at all levels.
- 5. To monitor the data based management system used by teachers of student with behavioral difficulties.
- 6. To assist in the presentation and development of relevant workshops and conferences that focus on children with behavior difficulties.
- 7. To assist Resource Compliance Specialists and teachers in the development of behavior IEP's.
- 8. To provide information and implement behavioral programs to the transportation staff to establish behavior management plans for use on buses.
- 9. To perform other duties as required by the Director of Exceptional Student Education and the Supervisor of Behavior Program.
