REPORTS TO: Director of Exceptional Student Education/Principal

POSITION GOAL: To screen Child Study Teams referrals, evaluation, plan for and instruct students who are

speech, language, and hearing impaired in need of bilingual services.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To assist other school personnel in identifying speech, language, and hearing impaired bilingual students.

- 2. To participate in prekindergarten and kindergarten bilingual screenings as requested.
- 3. To assess and prepare an evaluation report for bilingual students, as necessary.
- 4. To provide instruction designed to remediate speech and language deficiencies and assist bilingual students in coping with communication problems in regular classes.
- 5. To participate in staffings in an evaluative and instructional role of bilingual students, as required.
- 6. To provide information and education to parents of speech, language, and hearing impaired students needing bilingual services.
- 7. To attend meetings of speech therapists conducted by district ESE staff.
- 8. To participate in staff development activities designed to enhance professional growth.
- 9. To assist in the professional development of peers through participation in the Certificate of Clinical Competence certification program.
- 10. To perform all other duties as assigned by the Principal/Director of Exceptional Students Education.

TERM OF EMPLOYMENT: Ten (10) months – Teacher Salary Schedule

EVALUATION: Performance in this position will be evaluated by the Principal/Director of

Exceptional Students Education in accordance with the Collective Bargaining

Agreement.
