POSITION GOAL: To assist the Coordinator of Early Childhood and Elementary Education in the coordination

of elementary program K-3.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To assist in curriculum writing, compilation, dissemination, and implementation.

- 2. To assist in the examination, selection, and/or adoption of textbooks and other instructional materials.
- 3. To provide assistance to the schools in the implementation of curricula in all subject areas, especialy new curricula.
- 4. To assist in the compilation of data to evaluate current programs and projects.
- 5. To provide instructional support and assistance with concerns and needs through classroom visitation and meetings.
- 6. To assist with the coordination of Reading Is Fundamental (RIF).
- 7. To assist in the compilation of data for state reports.
- 8. To assist with the development and revision of district reporting forms, such as report cards, progress reports, etc.
- 9. To assist with interschool communication concerning elementary issues.
- 10. To assist in the development of district elementary brochures/handbooks/guidelines.
- 11. To perform other duties as assigned by the Coordinator of Early Childhood and Elementary Education, Executive Director of Instructional Programs, and Assistant Superintendent for Instruction.
